Refacing Ordering Guidelines

You have these conditions:



NOTE 1: Your new doors will have a 1/2" overlay. NOTE 2: Your new doors will not overlap where they meet in the corner.

Determine your door front sizes:

- 1. Download our helpful form to record your information the same way our website will ask for it. <u>Measurement Form</u>
- 2. Measure your end panel thickness. It will be 5/8" (0.625") or 3/4" (0.75").
- **3.** Measure your cabinet opening to the closest 1/16" (0.0625").

To determine the width:

- Measure the width of each opening from the frame to the inside corner (Dimension A & B) as shown in Exhibit 1.
- Substract 3/8" (0.375") from each width (A & B) to get the width of each door.

To determine the height:

- If you have doors and/or drawers on cabinets next to the opening, measure the total height from the top to the bottom of adjacent doors to get the height of each door that matches.
- If you have no adjacent doors to match, measure the height of the opening (Dimension C) and add 1" to get the height of each door.
- **4.** Write the dimensions of the doors you need on the measurement form.



What to order:

- Order 2 doors to cover opening with the dimensions determined above.
 Select Part Type: "Door, ISQC, hinge to cabinet" and "Door, ISQC, hinged to door."
- **2.** We will provide an install kit with instructions, all hinges and hardware needed.


